- Writing about the lifeboats and historical figure Grace Darling

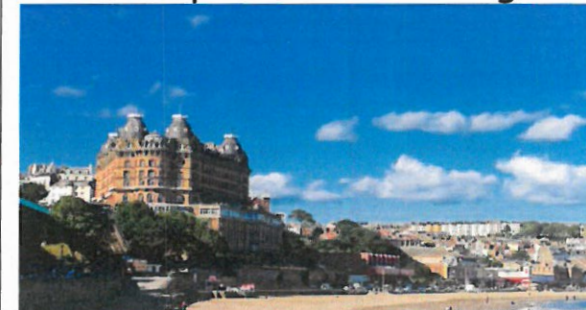
As mathematicians we will be:
