- Learning about plants – including parts of a flower, types of plant reproduction and plant adaptation

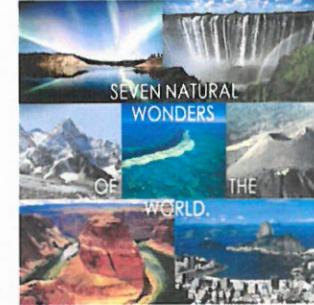
